

What should I already know?

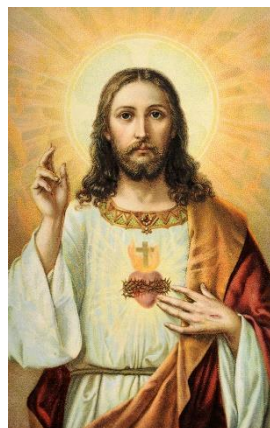
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

Key Vocabulary and Definitions

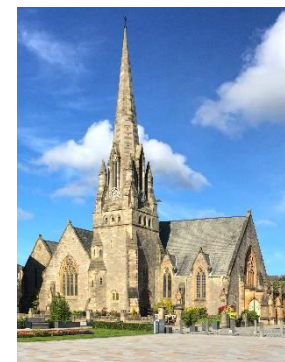
Christianity	A religion based on the teachings of Jesus.

Church	A Christian place of worship.
Easter	A time of year that Christians remember when Jesus came back to life.

Key Knowledge

- Easter is a special time of year for Christians. It happens during Spring.
- Easter happens on a Sunday. It is called Easter Sunday.
- The Friday before Easter is called Good Friday.
- Christians believe that Jesus died on the cross and came back to life.
- It is important to Christians because they remember when Jesus came back to life.
- Some people give and decorate Easter eggs. Easter eggs represent new life.
- Some people go to church.
- People also celebrate by eating a special meal with their family and friends.
