

**What should I already know?**

- There are different types of weather.
- The weather changes at different times of the year.
- Different things happen at different times in the year.

**Key Knowledge**

- There are 12 months in a year: January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.
- The year is split into 4 **seasons**: winter, spring, summer and autumn, they follow each other in a pattern.
- The weather in the United Kingdom can change from day to day. The four seasons have particular weather patterns.
- **Winter** in the United Kingdom - the **weather** is cold. It can be frosty, icy and there can be snow. It has to be freezing cold to snow.
- **Spring** in the United Kingdom - the **weather** starts to get warmer and there is more rain.
- **Summer** in the United Kingdom - the **temperature** is hotter and the **weather** is often sunny. The sun is hotter and stronger.
- **Autumn** in the United Kingdom - the **weather** starts to get colder and it can be more stormy. It gets windier and there is often rain.
- The weather affects what we do and what we wear.

**Key Vocabulary and Definitions**

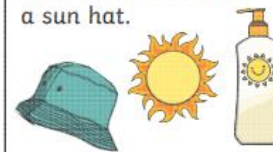
<b>Season</b>	A year can be split up into 4 parts with different weather and day length. We call these <b>seasons</b> .
<b>Weather</b>	The <b>weather</b> includes the <b>temperature</b> , wind speed and if it is raining, snowing, hailing, stormy, foggy, icy, cloudy and sunny.
<b>Temperature</b>	How hot or cold it is.
<b>Weather forecast</b>	In a weather forecast, symbols are used to show what the weather will be like in a particular area. Computers are used to help make accurate weather forecasts.
<b>United Kingdom</b>	Made up of England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Sometimes known as the UK.

The weather **affects** what we do and what we wear. If it is rainy, we wear **waterproof** clothes when we go outside.



If it is hot, we need to wear sun cream and a sun hat.
