

Year 1 Geography - Weather



What should I already know?

- There are different types of weather.
- The weather changes at different times of the year.
- Different things happen at different times in the year.

Key Knowledge

- There are 12 months in a year: January, February, March, April,
 May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.
- The year is split into 4 **seasons**: winter, spring, summer and autumn, they follow each other in a pattern.
- The weather in the United Kingdom can change from day to day. The four seasons have particular weather patterns.
- Winter in the United Kingdom the weather is cold. It can be frosty, icy and there can be snow. It has to be freezing cold to snow.
- **Spring** in the United Kingdom the **weather** starts to get warmer and there is more rain.
- **Summer** in the United Kingdom the **temperature** is hotter and the **weather** is often sunny. The sun is hotter and stronger.
- **Autumn** in the United Kingdom the **weather** starts to get colder and it can be more stormy. It gets windier and there is often rain.
- The weather affects what we do and what we wear.
