What should I already know?

- That people live in different places in the world.

Key Knowledge

- Human features in our world are things that have been made by people.
- Examples of human features include houses, shops, factories, schools, farms, harbours, ports, cities, towns and villages.
- Physical features in our world are things that have been made by nature, some which cannot be controlled by humans for example, seasons.
- Examples of **physical features** include weather, beaches, **coastlines**, forests, hills, rivers, mountains, **cliffs**, seas, seasons and soil.

Key Vocabulary and definitions

Human feature	Things in our world that have been made by people.
Physical feature	Things in our world that have been made by nature.
Village	A group of houses in the countryside.
Town	An area with houses and shops. It is larger than a village but smaller than a city.
City	A large town.
Harbour	An area of sea or river where ships and boats are kept.
Port	A town by the sea that has a harbour.
Cliff	A steep rock edge next to the sea.
Coastline	The area where the land meets the sea.
