Vocabulary	Definition
Monarch	A monarch, is the head of state, the leader of the country.  Monarchs usually have titles like king, queen, emperor, or empress  Monarchs usually rule until they die or give up their power.
Queen	A woman who rules her country.
Reign	The time that a monarch (king or queen) rules over their country.
Crowned	To put a crown on someone's head in an official ceremony that makes that person king or queen.
