Key Vocabulary and Definitions

2D	Flat, shapes that only have length and width.
3D	Not flat, shapes that have length, width and height.
collage	A piece of art that is made from a collection of different pieces and materials.
curl	Something with a small curved shape.
fringe	Loose hanging strips of paper or strands of fabric attached to the paper or fabric.
concertina	A zig zag fold where paper or card is folded forwards and backwards.
overlap	To place something so that a part of one covers a part of another.
texture	How something feels and/or looks like it would feel.
