

Year 1- Science - Animals including humans: Animals: Diet



What should I already know?

- Names of common pets, farm animals and jungle animals.
- Know that animals need to eat food.
- Understand that we should look after all living things.
- Notice that we can find animals in specific places (e.g., if you lift up a log you might find a minibeast, if you look in the trees you might see a bird).

Key Knowledge

- Pet animals are animals you have in your home to keep you company. Some common ones are: cats, dogs, fish, rabbits.
- Farm animals are animals that live on a farm and give us food. Some examples are: chickens, cows, goats, sheep, pigs.
- Wild animals as animals that live in nature. Some examples are: deer, owls, badgers and hedgehogs.
- Herbivores are animals that eat plants such as cows, rabbits and deer.
- Omnivores are animals that eat plants and animals such as fish, chickens, hedgehogs and squirrels.
- Carnivores are animals that eat other animals such as cats and owls.
