- Neil Armstrong was a famous astronaut.
- He was born in the United States of America.
- He was born in 1930 and died in 2012.
- He is famous for being the first man to walk on the moon.
- In 1969 he flew in a rocket to the moon. The spacecraft was called Apollo 11.
- On the 20<sup>th</sup> July 1969, he walked on the moon with another astronaut called Buzz Aldrin.
- This was an important moment in History because no one had walked on the moon before.
- When Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin were on the moon they took photos, did experiments and collected rocks.
