Key Vocabulary and definitions

wild plant	A plant that grows where its seeds fall. It doesn't need to be planted by a person or cared for as it grows.
garden plant	A plant that a person chooses to grow. It is planted by a person.
weeds	Wild plants that grow in places where people don't want them.
deciduous	A deciduous tree or plant loses its leaves each year. The leaves fall off of the tree in autumn or winter, then new leaves grow again in spring.
evergreen	An evergreen tree or plant keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter.
