

<u>Year 1 Curriculum Letter – Summer Half Term 1 – 2024</u>

Our theme this half term is:



This half term we will be exploring animals and the different animal groups and their features! We will be continuing our learning on the United Kingdom and it's countries, capital cities and seas. We will also explore Islam and Judaism,

focussing on how the two religions celebrate. We will also be learning about

David Attenborough.

Our theme will last for:

7 weeks.

Phonics

We will continue with phonics throughout this half term, please see our weekly curriculum information for specific sounds each week. The children will continue

- to:
 - Choose the correct graphemes to spell a word *say the word, segment the word, write the word.*
 - Apply sounds to read look at the letters, make the sounds, blend the sounds together.
 - Read and spell high frequency words correctly.



English

Our reading and writing will continue to focus on securing our understanding of the rules of spelling and grammar. The children will:

- Ensure finger spaces, full stops and capital letters are used correctly.
- Understand how to form a sentence that makes sense.
- Begin to use *and* to join sentences and words in a list.
- Begin to use *because* to extend sentences.
- Use the suffixes -s and -es to form plurals.
- Use the prefix -un.
- Begin to form the past tense correctly.
- Learn to read and spell tricky words have, there, out, like, little, Mr, Mrs, looked, called, asked, could, water, where, oh, some, their, people, who, again, though, through, many, pull, full, laughed, any, because, put, push
- Write a persuasive letter to David Attenborough.
- Write an animal fact file.

Children will take part in Guided Reading, Book Talk and individual reading

sessions to further improve reading skills, specifically focussing on

comprehension skills.






