Dear parents and carers,

I hope you had a relaxing break. It has been wonderful to welcome the children back and it has been great to see the sun finally making an appearance this week.

In assembly this week Mrs Coplin and I talked to the children about behaviour and expectations. We have recently made some changes to improve behaviour when walking around school and the children have adapted so well to this and are being very sensible in the corridors.



We are seeing more and more children attending school in tracksuits. Tracksuits are acceptable when the children are asked to come into school in PE clothes and should be in school colours – navy, grey or black, preferably without large logos or branding.

However, there are many children wearing tracksuits on days when they are not taking part in PE. Please can we remind you unless children are asked to come into school wearing sports wear they should be wearing clothes which adhere to the school uniform requirements.
