

What should I already know?

- To be familiar with a computer keyboard
- To be able to recognise letters and numbers on a keyboard.

Key Vocabulary and definitions

Word processor	An app for typing.
Keyboard	A device that when you type, symbols appear on the screen.
Space bar	Start a new word.
Backspace	Delete/remove text.
Caps Lock	Turn a letter into a capital letter.
Undo	To change the last command.
Bold	Changing the text so that it stands out .
Italic	Changing the text so it is <i>slanted</i> .
