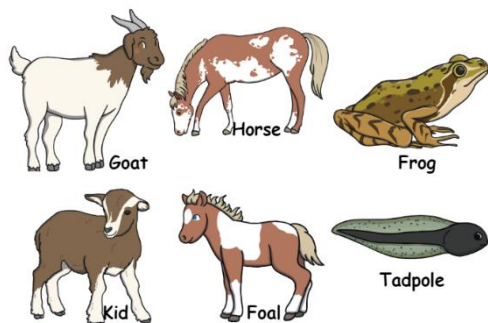
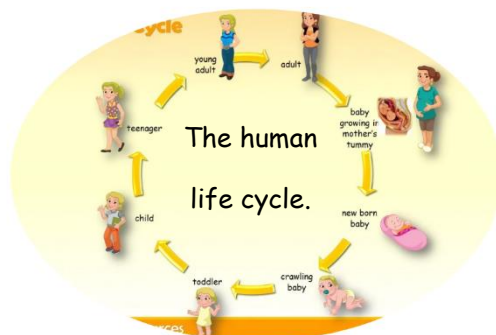


What should I already know?

Vagina	The inside part of a female body, part of her private area.
Vulva	The outside part of a female body which they use to pass urine. Part of his private area.
