Key Vocabulary and definitions E-book An electronic version of a printed book that can be read on a computer or a specifically designed handheld device. A document containing all the important information about Fact File one subject. A book or story that is written about imaginary characters and Fiction events and not based on real people or places. Writing that is a bout real people or events rather than stories Non-Fiction that have been made up. A tool for organising and representing knowledge. They form a Mind Map web of ideas which are all interconnected. A way to represent a concept or idea using text and/or Node images. A test of knowledge, especially as a competition between Quiz individuals for a team as a form of entertainment. A way of displaying information about a subject to an Presentation audience.

Key Questions

What do we need to think about when planning a presentation?

The important thing to consider is the audience. Think about how old they are and what they would find interesting. For younger children, a presentation with pictures may be more appropriate.

Why should I plan out my presentation?

Planning out your presentation allows you to make sure you have included all the information you need to. It is easier to do this in the planning phase rather than when you have started the presentation.
