| instruments | Objects that can be used to make sounds. |
| beat | A steady beat (pattern) that stays the same all through a piece of music. |
| tempo | The speed of the music. |

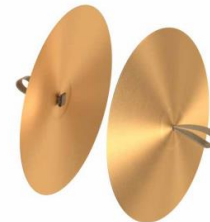
