Key Vocabulary and Definitions

	Definition
voice sounds	Sounds that you make with your mouth and throat.
body percussion	Sounds that you make with your body.
music	Music is a group of sounds that people have arranged in a pleasing or meaningful way.
instruments	Objects that can be used to make sounds.
beat	A steady beat (pattern) that stays the same all through a piece of music.
tempo	The speed of the music, fast or slow
high	A high, squeaky sound eg. a mouse squeaking, the ting of a triangle instrument.
low	A deep, low sound eg. the roar of a lion, the voice of a giant the sound of a big drum

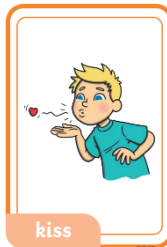
