- Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) taught all Muslims how to follow God.



Muslims believe that:


- Allah sent down the Qur'an to Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) through angel Jibril (Gabriel).

- The first pillar is **belief** shahadah.
- The second pillar is prayer salah
