Key Vocabulary and definitions

<b>Carnivore</b>	An animal that eats other animals.
<b>Herbivore</b>	An animal that eats plants.
<b>Omnivore</b>	An animal that eats plants and other animals.

Key Knowledge

- All **mammals**, **birds**, **fish**, **amphibians** and **reptiles** need air, water, food and shelter to survive.
- **Mammals** have fur or hair on their body.
- **Mammals** are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores.
- Humans are **mammals**.
- **Birds** have feathers, wings and a beak.
- Some **birds** can fly and some **birds** cannot fly.
- **Fish** are animals that live in the water.
- **Fish** have gills that they use to breathe.
- **Amphibians** live on land and in water.
- **Amphibians** do not have scales on their bodies.
- Some **amphibians** have webbed feet.
- **Reptiles** have dry scales on their bodies.
- **Reptiles** need direct heat to survive.

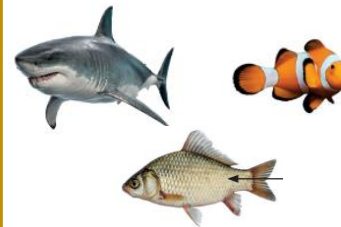
