Dear parents and carers,

We have had a busy start to this half term. The children have returned full of smiles and eager to learn. Staff have been working hard on finalising assessments and wrting reports and we are also beginning to prepare for next academic year.

# **Transition**

I thought it would be useful to share some information about transition for children moving to the next year group. Over the years we have developed a strong transition programme that allows the children to move to their new class confidently. I have included some of the things we do to support the children's transition to the next year group.

#### Year 2

- Playtimes in the Junior playground.
- Tour of the Junior School.
- Staff from the Junior School will visit the children in their current classrooms.
- Children will spend the day in their new classrooms on Tuesday 9th July.
- Groups of Year 3 children will visit Year 2 classrooms and Yr 3 children will be able to answer any questions the Yr 2 children may have.

## Year I and Reception

- Children will spend the day in their new classrooms on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July.
- Parents will be able to meet their child's new class teacher and visit the classroom at 3:30pm on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July.
- Reception children will begin to play in the KS1 playground at playtimes over the next few weeks
- Staff will begin to point out Year 1 and Year 2 classrooms to children as they walk around school.
- Children will write a letter/draw a picture for their new class teacher to help them get to know them.
- The initial three days of the new academic year will focus on building relationships between children and staff.
- Assemblies and circle time sessions will focus on what is the same and what is different about their new year group.

#### Pre-school

- Children will visit the Reception playground and classes over the next few weeks.
- New Starters meeting will be on Tuesday 11th June for parents to meet Reception staff.
- Children will visit their new classroom and meet their teacher on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July.
- Staff will carry out home visits at the beginning of next academic, to begin to build relationships with children and parents.
- Time will be spent in the first few days getting to know the children and allowing them to familiarise themselves with the school environment.

There is also dedicated transiton time for staff to meet to handover information to the new class teacher.

You will be informed of your child's new class teacher when you receive your child's end of year report on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July.
